Dean & Director's Message

At the outset, I would like to extend warm New Year greetings to the staff and students of GDCRI & Alumni Members.

The College Food Fest "Suchi-Ruchi" 2012 was conducted at the Gurumurthy Hall on 17th November 2012. The staff and students participated with zest and enthusiasm. The annual alumni meet "Sparsha" was celebrated with great fervour at the Ramachandra Auditorium on 12th December



2012. A cultural show was put up by the students and it was a memorable day for all the alumni members who attended the function. The college cultural Fest Myth 2012 spanning over a period of 3 days saw enthusiastic involvement of all the staff and students.

Continual efforts are being made to improve the college infrastructure. The high power voltage transformer has been installed, which has solved the problem of voltage fluctuation at the institute. Further, work towards the installation of the elevator in the college is going on in full swing and the civil work of the project is more than half completed.

The Department of Prosthodontics along with the GDCRI alumni association and the Indian Medical Association Gundlupet organized a free Complete Denture Camp at Gundlupet on 9th and 10th February 2013. The team of 110 members (55 doctors and 55 technicians) worked overnight to provide complete denture to 131 patients in a single day. The dentures were processed and delivered at the campsite itself, which is a herculean task. The patients as well as the public really appreciated the service provided at the camp. GDCRI, at this denture camp has improved its own record of providing 108 dentures in one day at Chikkanayakanahalli four years ago.

A number of CDE programmes have been conducted at the institution for the benefit of the staff and students. The Department of Endodontics conducted a CDE program addressing important topics in Endodontics such as rotary and laser endodontics. The Department of Prosthodontics conducted a CDE programme on Zygomatic and Diem 2 concept. For the first time in the country a live surgical demonstration of the Zygomatic and Diem 2 concepts was performed.

I extend my heartfelt congratulations to one of the young staff members of GDCRI, Dr. Kiran Kumar, who has become a senate member of the RGUHS by election and not selection. I would like to wish him luck for all his future endeavours. Let us conclude by hoping that the year 2013 brings more laurels to our esteemed institute and GDCRI reaches greater heights and excels in every field.

The follow-up for the patients was also done after 1 week to attend to the complaints of the patients.
